1. Purpose

This document specifies GESB's data requirements for any employers or data sources who wish to submit contributions data using the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) eXtensible Business Reporting Language (XBRL).

GESB has certain specific data requirements to administer West State Super and GESB Super which may differ from other superannuation funds therefore, employers or data sources wishing to use this format MUST comply with the requirements outlined in this document. This is important as the data supplied can have a significant impact on your employee's superannuation account and associated insurance.

Should the required data elements outlined in this document not be provided, GESB may reject and return a particular transaction or the entire submission.

Data fields required by GESB have been fully specified in this document. Fields which are part of the standard but not used by GESB have not been fully specified. GESB expects employers to adhere to the Contributions Message Implementation Guide (MIG) v1.4 Standard and as a minimum, provide all mandatory fields.

Any future changes to the data standards required by the ATO will need to be adhered to.

This document should be read in conjunction with items listed in the Key References section.

2. Acceptable Contributions

The following contribution types can be accepted for GESB Super and West State Super:

- Employer Contributions Superannuation Guarantee Amount
- Personal Contributions Amount
- Employer Contributions Salary Sacrificed Amount

GESB will reject any other contribution types received.


GESB <u>will not</u> accept contributions via XBRL for other APRA regulated or Complying Self-Managed Super funds (commonly referred to as 'choice' funds) nominated by an employee on a standard choice form.

Contributions <u>cannot</u> be accepted via XBRL for Gold State Super or the State Pension and Provident schemes. All contributions to these products must continue to be submitted in accordance with GESB's Data Exchange Standards (DES) v5.6 and submitted via GESB's Employer Online service.

3. Submitting Contributions to GESB via XBRL

Employers submitting contributions to GESB's West State Super and GESB Super products by XBRL must do so in accordance with the AS4 profile of ebMS 3.0 via the Superannuation Transaction Network (STN).

XBRL is an international standard for electronic communication of business data. ebMS is the messaging system used for the transmission of the XBRL data. The STN ensures SuperStream XBRL / ebMS messages are delivered to GESB's gateway in a reliable, efficient and secure manner.



4. Payment Methods

Contribution payments must be made in accordance with BECS Direct Entry (BECS DE) System maintained by the Australian Payment Clearing Association (APCA). GESB does not currently accept employer contribution payments via BPAY.

Payments must include a payment reference number, generated using the 'Concatenation method' as specified in the Payment Methods document. This ensures electronic payments (which flow via the banking system) and the related superannuation transaction details (which flow via the data messaging system) can be reconciled efficiently.

5. New Member Numbers

The receipt of a Member Registration Request message can result in the creation of a new GESB member account when details provided (i.e. TFN, Name, date of birth, member number) do not match existing member details on the system.

Where a new GESB member account is created, the unique identifier or member number associated with the new account will be supplied back to the employer via a Member Registration Outcome Response message.

6. Superannuation Overpayments / Negative Contributions

GESB does not permit the recovery of overpaid contributions through the submission of negative contributions via the XBRL channel. Should a negative contribution be detected in a contribution submission, the entire submission and its associated payment will be rejected and returned to the employer for correction.

7. Member Tax File Number (TFN)

Where the member has provided their TFN to their employer, the TFN **MUST** be populated in the entity identifier field in the 'Superannuation Fund Member Context Identifier' section of the message.

If a member has NOT provided their TFN to their employer, the 'Superannuation Fund Member Context Identifier' section of the message **MUST** contain the employee identifier/ payroll number.

Note the context specifications described in the SuperStream standards have not been listed in this document. Further details on the context specifications required can be found in the ATO Contributions MIG v1.4 listed in the Key References section of this document.

8. Superannuation Guarantee Charge

If you don't pay the minimum amount of super guarantee (SG) for your employee into the correct fund by the required date, you may have to pay the Superannuation Guarantee Charge (SGC).

Historically, these contributions could be paid for GESB members as an 'interest' payment using GESB's Data Exchange Standards (DES).

The SuperStream data standards do not allow an interest contribution to be provided; therefore if employers are required to pay the SGC, this must be done in accordance with the process specified by the Australian Taxation Office (ATO). 9. SuperStream Contribution Business Interactions

The remainder of this document details the following SuperStream Contribution Business Interactions:

- Member Registration Request (MRR)
- Contribution Transaction Request (CTR)

Other interactions include:

- Member Registration Outcome Response errors, new member numbers and confirmation of updates
- Contribution Transaction Error Responses- error when a message cannot be processed

When a message cannot be processed, GESB will send a MROR and/or Contribution Transaction Error Response (CTER) with an accompanying error message. When a CTER is returned, the monies will also be returned to the bank account recorded on GESB's system for the employer.

Note: Monies and messages sent to an incorrect GESB product will be returned to the employer. For example, if a member with a West State Super account is sent using a GESB Super USI it will be rejected and returned to the employer.

For more details on return messages please refer to the Contributions MIG 1.4 and the Data and Payment Standards Error Code Management.

10. Member Registration Request (MRR) Overview

The MRR performs a number of functions. It enables the employer to:

- Create a GESB membership for new employees where GESB is the employer's default fund*
- Create an employer / employee relationship for new employees*
- Provide GESB with updated details for existing employees

*An MRR <u>must</u> be used to advise GESB of a new employee appointment. If an MRR is not received, any CTR will be rejected and monies returned.

The Employer must use the specific USI for GESB Super or West State Super otherwise the message will be rejected.
