We're introducing a fortnightly pension payment option

July 2026

We regularly review our retirement products to ensure they continue to meet your needs.

To help you manage your day-to-day budget and retirement income, we're introducing a fortnightly pension payment option for:

- RI Allocated Pension
- Transition to Retirement Pension

This change will come into effect on 30 July 2026.

How do I change my payment frequency?

You can change how often you receive your pension payments through Member Online by logging in at mol.gesb.wa.gov.au.

Alternatively, you can complete and post a *Retirement Income Pension change of details and pension payment variation form*, available at gesb.wa.gov.au/forms.

When changing your pension payments, remember to review any scheduled payments or direct debits from your bank account to ensure you'll have enough funds.

When will fortnightly pensions be paid?

Fortnightly pension payments will be paid on or before the Thursday of each fortnight.

If a scheduled payment falls on a public holiday, it will be processed on the business day before.
